Solo Flight

Solo flight occurs after a student has completed approximately 10-20 hours of dual flight instruction with a Certified Flight Instructor. A student must be able to demonstrate mastery of the fundamentals of flying a single engine plane.

Private Pilot

This certificate can be earned with a minimum of 50 hours and allows students to be the pilot-in-command of a single engine airplane. Trained to operate an airplane safely with the proper decision making processes makes this program distinct.

Commercial Rating

Becoming a commercial pilot allows one to operate an airplane for compensation. This program is highly specialized in the areas of cross-country flight, weather management, aeronautical concepts and flight planning. This certification allows a pilot to be hired as a professional pilot.
